


Mission Plan

ENVISAGED TIME FRAME: SEPTEMBER 2014 – AUGUST 2017

Service Evangelism	Nothing of this nature is currently carried out.	<p>During the summer months a team of workers will carry out evangelism in local community by carrying out work in the community (gardening, tidying, painting, etc).</p> <p>The team will contain some members who have a gift for evangelism who will talk to those benefitting from the service (or indeed interested passer-bys).</p> <p>The team will be provided with church literature and newsletters to distribute to interested persons.</p>	<p>Joint project with Molesworth if they are planning similar action.</p> <p>The team should consist of eager volunteers of workers plus some with a gift for evangelism.</p> <p>Not all team members need to have the gift of evangelism, but some must.</p> <p>The services must be for those outside the church – not for church members.</p>
Sport Evangelism	Other than bowls, nothing of this nature is currently carried out.	The church will form a sporting club to which would have a core of Christians but would also attract non-Christians, and which would give believers exercise friendship evangelism.	<p>Suitable sport(s) to be identified. (e.g. – badminton, football)</p> <p>Suitable venue (church premises may not be suitable or available) to be identified.</p> <p>Core of mission minded Christians with an interest in the relevant sport(s) required.</p>

Drive-in church	Nothing of this nature is currently carried out.	<p>The church would organise a series of drive-in church services in a local venue.</p> <p>(Where it has been tried this type of event has been seen to attract Roman Catholics who would not normally dream of entering a Protestant church.)</p>	<p>This project would be suitable for joint work with another church.</p> <p>Suitable field and speaker needed.</p> <p>This will require a lot of advance planning by a dedicated planning team.</p>
“Fit for life”, health and beauty events	Nothing of this nature is currently carried out.	The church would arrange these types of event on a regular basis, frequency depending on demand. Each event would be designed to attract non-Christians by is advertising and content, and would incorporate mission into its program.	Small planning team required. Input needed from members of the congregation with required interest and skills.
Christianity Explored / Alpha Course	Nothing of this nature is currently carried out.	<p>The church would organise a one-off course during the lifespan of this stage of the plan.</p> <p>If it was successful follow up courses could be planned.</p>	<p>This would be suitable as a joint project with another church.</p> <p>Advertising is the key to success of this type of event.</p> <p>This could be run off-site (local hotel?)</p>
